- 1 Temple** (heart of Marais): large 1-2 bedroom on 2nd floor)
- 2 Lescot** (Marais/Les Halles) 1 bedroom, penthouse on 6th floor with elevator
- 3 Stuart** (Montorgueil area) spacious studio flat, ground floor

TEMPLE 1 and a half Bedroom (Le Marais):

This large 1/2 bedroom apartment sleeps 2 to 4 people. Besides a main bedroom, it contains another open room /study with a large leather sofa, which can sleep additional 2 people. There is a living, large, luxuriously equipped, open kitchen, separate restroom and a spacious bathroom. Entirely renovated in December 2003 designer couches, wooden closets, Persian rugs etc.

Area:

In the very heart of the prestigious *Marais* district, which ever since the Middle Ages has attracted aristocrats, writers, artists and designers. Today *Le Marais* features fashion boutiques, fabulous restaurants, art galleries and cafés-théâtres. A few steps from the Pompidou modern art center on one side, and the Place des Vosges on the other. In the center of the gay «village» of the Marais. Walk south for a couple of minutes and you come face to face with the Ile Saint-louis. 5 minutes walk from metro stations: Hôtel de Ville, Saint-Paul or Rambuteau.

Apartment features:

The apartment is well appointed with both real antique furniture and modern deluxe comfort:

- air-conditioning, free broadband internet hook-up

This «Hôtel Particulier» attached to the famous Hotel des Ambassadeurs de Hollande, has a very large tree-filled courtyard, restored to a remarkably splendid state. A «gardien» or caretaker lives on the premises. The apartment is equipped with door code and intercom. [a parking (optional) is situated beneath the building].

Lescot (Marais/ Les Halles):) 1 bedroom, penthouse on 6th floor with elevator

This luxury smaller penthouse apartment in the very center of Paris (1st district) is situated exactly on the border of Marais and Les Halles. All 3 windows have beautiful views on central Paris: mostly on pedestrian square «la petite Truanderie» below and its 18th century houses, further away one sees a tower of the Louvre Chapel, the roof of a medieval Crusaders' church St. Leu, and the famous Montmartre's Sacre Coeur church far to the north.

It is a 1 bedroom apartment, sleeps ideally 2 people or possibly 3/4 people (or couple with 2 kids). Besides the bedroom with desk area, flat contains a living, a bathroom and small kitchen. The apartment, entirely renovated March 2005, is well appointed with a mix of real antiques and modern comforts.. Area:

This street (famously described by Emil Zola) is named after Pierre Lescot, the 16th century architect of the Louvre. Its is a pedestrian street in the historical heart of Paris, linking rue de Rivoli and Les Halles. This area has been Paris's central market ever since the Middle Ages. Today the street Pierre Lescot features food stores, fashion and designer boutiques, bistros, and terrace cafés.

Lescot (Marais/Les Halles) –continued

- A few steps from the Centre Pompidou Modern Art Museum
 - Walk south for a couple of minutes to the Seine river and you come face to face with Ile Saint-louis - Less than a block from subway entrances of Châtelet-Les Halles and Etienne Marcel
- Apartment features:
- Bedroom: high-quality EXTRA LARGE queensize double bed, custom egyptian 300+ thread linen, goose down duvets and soft beaded lighting, wooden hanging closets
 - Study area with free high-speed internet hookup (pc rental possible), direct dial telephone set to local - Large Flat screen LCD/Plasma tv, DVD
 - Living also has a large leather designer couch (with double-size mattress), which in one automatic movement turns into a sleeper sofa (bed is already made inside).
 - Living is adorned with antique wooden beams and parquet floors, authentic red brick wall and Persian rugs.

Stuart (Montorgueil): spacious groundfloor studio apartment
